

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SYNOPSIS - 1 LINE

A desperate mother hides her dying son in a secluded cabin to heal him using unnerving natural remedies.

SYNOPSIS - 3 LINE

A desperate mother cares for her dying son at an isolated cabin deep in the woods. Tensions rises as her oldest son's ideas of treating his brother differ from her own. The two continue to clash until everything spirals out of their control.

SYNOPSIS - SHORT (100 WORD)

A desperate mother cares for her dying son, Cole, using natural remedies at a cabin deep in the woods in an attempt to escape the medical field. There is tension between her and her eldest son, Travis, who suggests taking him to the doctor. As Cole's health and the tension between her and Travis continues to stray, everything begins to spiral out of her control. Her worst nightmare creeps its way into the cabin forcing her to make a difficult decision—to trust the medical professionals or to continue on her path of natural remedies.

SYNOPSIS - LONG (200 WORD)

A desperate mother cares for her dying son, Cole, using natural remedies at a cabin deep in the woods in an attempt to escape the medical field. Her unnerving natural treatments make it impossible to track if Cole has had any progress, leaving her oldest son Travis wanting to take him to an actual doctor. As Cole's health and the tension between her and Travis continues to stray, everything begins to spiral out of her control. Paranoia creeps into her mind, and her worst fears start to come true. The medical field shows up at the cabin and begins forcing their treatments on Cole in an attempt to cure him. Grace tries to fight it but finds herself in a hospital desperately trying to see Cole and bring him to safety. After finding Cole hooked up to several machines, she is confronted by a doctor who forces her to make a difficult decision--to trust the medical professionals or to continue on her path of natural remedies and risk her son's life.

STATEMENT FROM THE DIRECTOR

"Remedy" is a passion project I have wanted to make for years which examines the forms of natural and medical treatments and the ups and downs to both. This idea stems from the story of my brother Jonathan who explored both chemotherapy and natural forms of treatment to combat his cancer. As my mother was the main primary caretaker for him throughout this journey, she felt a daunting pressure from the medical field to continue with the chemo treatments even though they continued to prove ineffective and weaken his immune system. She then turned to alternative treatments which in the end proved to be ineffective as well. As "Remedy" explores this topic, it also shows the great tole a sickness can take on a family as well as the destruction of both the mental and physical health of all of those involved. I hope after watching "Remedy," the viewer is left contemplating the themes and topics explored in this film.


Charlotte Bjornbak
